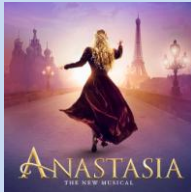


Aladdin

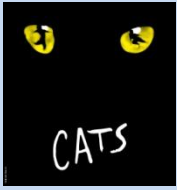


A Bronx Tale The Musical

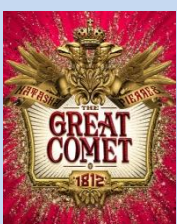


The Glass Menagerie

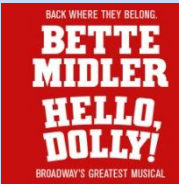


Groundhog Day

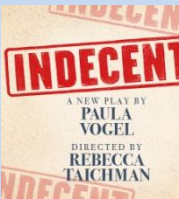


Hello, Dolly!

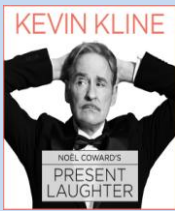


The Play That Goes Wrong

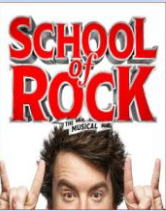


Present Laughter

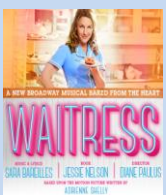
